# The Firefighters' Pension Scheme (Contributions) Amendment (Scotland) Order 2012

Made - - - 2012

Laid before the Scottish Parliament 2012

Coming into force - - 1st April 2012

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 26(5) of the Fire Services Act 1947(**a**), sections 12 and 16 of the Superannuation Act 1972(**b**) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

#### Citation, commencement, effect and extent

- **1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Firefighters' Pension Scheme (Contributions) Amendment (Scotland) Order 2012.
  - (2) This Order comes into force on 1st April 2012.
  - (3) This Order extends to Scotland only.

Section 26 of the 1947 Act was amended by section 1 of the Fire Services Act 1951 (c.27), section 42 of the Reserve and Auxiliary Forces (Protection of Civil Interests) Act 1951 (c.65), section 33 of, and Schedule 3 to, the Theft Act 1968 (c.60), sections 16 and 29 of, and Schedule 8 to, the Superannuation Act 1972 (c.11), section 100 of, and Schedule 27 to, the Social Security Act 1973 (c.38), section 1 of, and Schedule 1 to, the Social Security (Consequential Provisions) Act 1975 (c.18), section 32 of the Magistrates' Courts Act 1980 (c.43), article 2 of the Social Security (Modification of Fire Services Act 1947) Order 1976 (S.I. 1976/551), section 1 of the Police and Firemen's Pensions Act 1997 (c.52) and section 256 of, and Schedule 25 to, the Civil Partnership Act 2004 (c.33). The functions of the Secretary of State as regards Scotland were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of article 2 of and Schedule 1 to the Scotland Act 1998 (Transfer of Functions to the Scottish Ministers etc.) Order 2006, (S.I. 2006/304).

### AMENDMENT OF THE FIREFIGHTERS' PENSION SCHEME

In rule G2 (pension contributions) of Part G (pensionable pay and contributions) for paragraph (1A) substitute –

"(1A)(a) Subject to sub-paragraph (c), from 1st April 2012 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2013, the contribution rate is to be determined on the basis of the pensionable pay of a regular firefighter, as notified to the firefighter by the authority within 30 days of 1<sup>st</sup> April 2012, in accordance with the following table:

Pensionable pay band	Contribution rate from 1 <sup>st</sup> April 2012 to 31st March 2013
Up to and including £15,000	11.0%
More than £15,000 and up to and including £21,000	11.6%
More than £21,000 and up to and including £30,000	12.3%
More than £30,000 and up to and including £40,000	12.4%
More than £40,000 and up to and including £50,000	12.6%
More than £50,000 and up to and including £60,000	12.8%
More than £60,000 and up to and including £100,000	13.0%
More than £100,000 and up to and including £120,000	13.1%
More than £120,000	13.3%

- (b) Where the contribution rate under sub-paragraph (a) relates to a part-time regular firefighter, the contribution rate which applies to him or her shall be determined in accordance with sub-paragraph (a) on the basis of the pensionable pay of a whole-time regular firefighter.
- (c) Where in the course of the year there is a permanent change to the terms and conditions of a regular firefighter's employment which affects his or her pensionable pay during the year such that the firefighter falls into a different pay band to that applied at the beginning of the year, the contribution rate shall be adjusted from the date that the pensionable pay is changed, as notified to the firefighter by the authority, to that of the applicable new band.
- (d) For the purposes of calculating the appropriate pensionable pay band in the table set out in paragraph (1A)(a), pensionable pay does not include any pensionable benefits paid to a regular firefighter by his or her employing authority under rule B5C(5) but those payments will be included in pensionable pay for the purposes of calculating the pension contribution to be paid."
