## THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PENSION SCHEME (SCOTLAND) AMENDMENT (No. 1) REGULATIONS 2006 - TRANSPORT PARTNERSHIPS

Our letter dated 7<sup>th</sup> October 2005 advised consultees of proposed amendments to the Local Government Pension Scheme (Scotland) Regulations 1998 which would be necessary as a result of the Transport (Scotland) Act 2005.
