Dear colleague,

Scottish Public Pensions Agency have advised that 2021 Annual Benefit Statements for active members of the Scottish Teachers' Pension Schemes will be available from 31 August 2021 on SPPA Online Member Services.

Your Annual Benefit Statement includes:

- Accrued pension benefits
- · Current level of death benefits
- Lifetime Allowance (LTA) information

To qualify for 2021 Annual Benefit Statement:

- you must have paid pension contributions between 01/4/2020 and 31/03/2021
- You must have been an active contributing member of the scheme at 31/03/2021 and at the point the statement is calculated

SPPA have a small quantity of ABS still to produce for some active members, if your 2021 statement is not available when you log-on to the member portal, then please recheck again prior to 31 October before contacting the SPPA.
